



Chef Salads are available to replace Hot Meals, Turkey & Cheese Sandwiches are available to replace the main Entrée of a Meal. All substitutions need to be made by 7:00AM. 2% Milk is served daily.

To inquire about ingredient content, please call the Senior Nutrition Manager.


