Apply for the Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program.

Maumee Valley Planning Organization has funds available for home repairs which address health and safety issues in the home. To qualify your household income needs to be below 80% of median income, be the home owner, have homeowners insurance, and have property taxes paid to date. Some examples of eligible repairs; Roofs, Gutters, Lead Paint, Heating System, Plumbing, Electrical, Structural & Accessibility.




