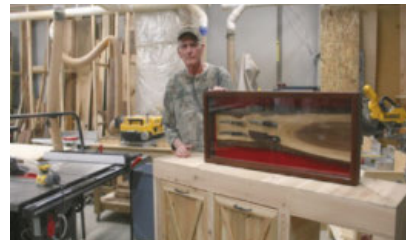

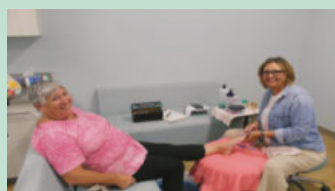

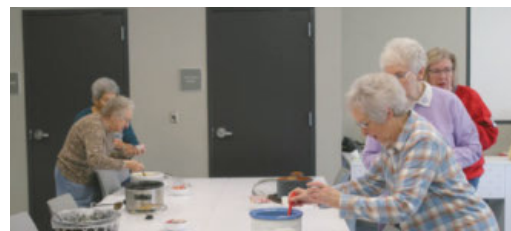
TRANSPORTATION SERVICES
