Rummage Sale & Bake Sale

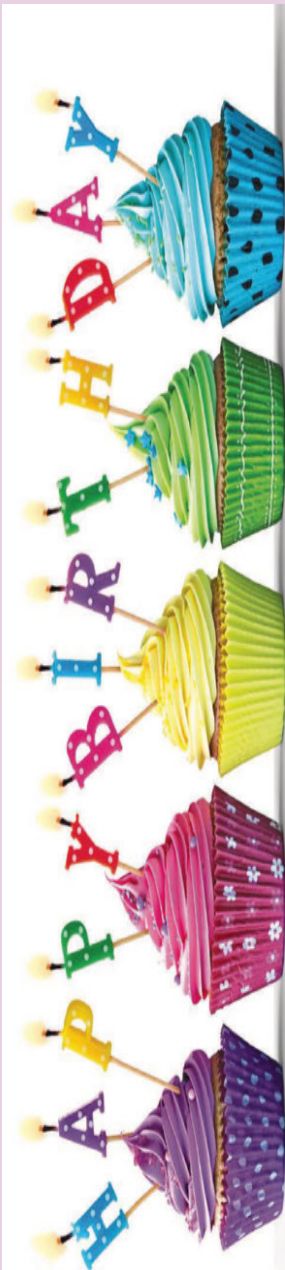

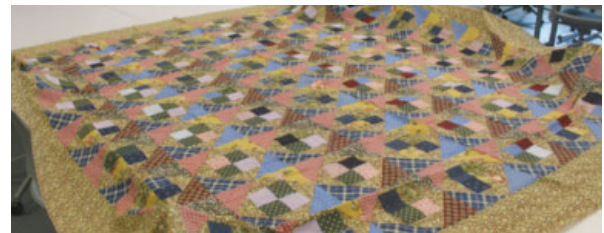

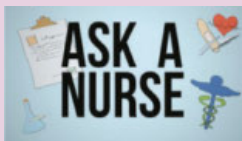
Frozen Meals will be delivered to Meals on Wheels clients (at an earlier date) for the Holidays that the Senior Center is closed, if requested.

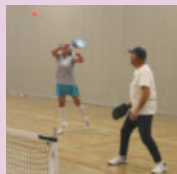
