Thank you for bringing your spirit, your stories, and your laughter to our community. Wishing you a June filled with sunshine, good health, and moments that make you smile.

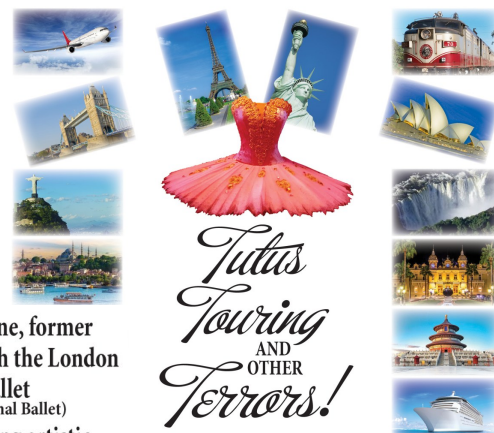

Chef Salads are available to replace Hot Meals, Turkey & Cheese Sandwiches are available to replace the main Entrée of a Meal. All substitutions need to be made by 7:00AM. 2% Milk is served daily.

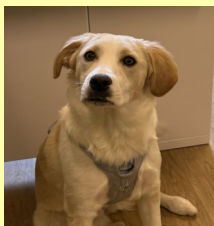

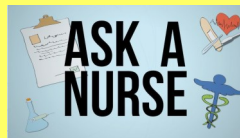
